The Chairman welcomed the members to the meeting. The minutes of last meeting has been circulated to all members. No comments were received. Committee confirmed the minutes of the 12<sup>th</sup> meeting.

ITEM NO.1	Administrative approval and expenditure sanction for
	the construction of Indoor Sports complex
Resolution No.	The committee has been informed that this institute is a
34/2012	residential institute. In order to provide extracurricular activities an indoor sports infrastructure is required. Accordingly, the architectural consultants M/s CPG India Pvt. Ltd. (CPGI) has finalized the indoor sports complex design and drawing with followingprovisions such as basketball/badminton court, store, office, lobby, squash court, table tennis, gymnasium, swimming pool, balancing tank and plant room, change rooms etc.  Accordingly CPWD has been requested to give estimates for accord of
	Administrative approval and expenditure sanction. The same is placed as Annexure-1.  The committee was further informed that CPWD has forwarded a preliminary estimate for₹ 15,54,03,000/- including 3% contingencies

(Annexure-1). The time limit prescribed by CPWD in the preliminary estimate is 6 months for planning and 18 months for execution. The estimate has been framed based on the approved plinth area rate of Govt of India.

The Building and Works Committee deliberated the above provisions and the estimate and resolved accord Administrative approval and Expenditure Sanction for ₹ 15,54,03,000/-(Rupees Fifteen crores Fifty four lakhs and Three thousand only) for taking up this work.

#### ITEM NO.2

# Administrative approval and expenditure sanction for the construction of80units of Faculty Housing

## Resolution No. 35/2012

The committee has been appraised that the B.O.G in its  $14^{th}$  meeting has approved to take up faculty housing with a built up area 18000 sqm based on the recommendation of BWC in its  $6^{th}$  meeting resolution No.3/2010 item No.1

The DPR2003 has made a provision for building 100 units of faculty housing vide Para 11.3 Table4.0.

The architectural consultant M/s CPG India Pvt. Ltd. (CPGI) has finalized the master plan with the provision of two blocks for faculty housing. It has been decided to take up one block in phase-1.

Accordingly the CPGI has finalized architectural design for faculty housing Block-1. As per the design, the building has been provided with RC frame structure with raft foundation of G+10 floors. This block will consist of 60 units of type -IV, 20 units of type-V. The living area as administrated by Govt of India for these types of quarters have been taken into consideration and moderated to suit the multistoried design.

As per the drawing in type-IV units Living/Dining-1no., Bed rooms-2nos., Toilets-2nos. and Kitchen facilities made and in type-V unitsLiving/Dining-1no., Bed rooms-3nos., Toilets-3nos. and Kitchen facilities made. It has been provided with all the services including lift.

Accordingly CPWD has been requested to give estimates for accord of Administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

The committee has been informed that based on the request CPWD has forwarded a preliminary estimate for ₹38,91,35,000/- including 3% contingencies (Annexure-2). The time limit prescribed by CPWD in the preliminary estimate is 6months for planning and 18months for execution. The estimate has been framed based on the approved plinth area rate of Govt of India.

The Building and Works Committee deliberated the above provisions and the estimate and resolved to recommend to FC and B.O.G for accord of Administrative approval and Expenditure Sanction for ₹38,91,35,000/-(Rupees Thirty eight crores ninety one lakhs thirty five thousand only) for taking up this work.

Administrative approval and expenditure sanction for the construction of Transit Hostel, GuestHouse, Shopping center and Medical inspection roomin a single block at new campus

## Resolution No. 36/2012

The committee has been informed that the B.O.G in its 14<sup>th</sup>meeting has approved to take up 50units of Transit Hostel with a plinth area 4600 sqm and 50 rooms of guest house with a plinth area 2500sqm based on the recommendation of BWC in its 6<sup>th</sup> meeting resolution No.3/2010 item No.1

The DPR2003 has made a provision for building 50 units of Transithostel with 2000sqm and 50 beds of Guest house with 2000sqm vide Para 11.3 Table 4.0.

The architectural consultant M/s CPG India Pvt. Ltd. (CPGI)has finalized architectural design for Transit hostel, Guest house, Shopping center and Medical Inspection in a single building.

As per the design the building has been provided with RC frame structure with raft foundation of G+12 floors. This block will consist of shops-6nos., Medical care unit, Transit houses-84nos., Guest rooms-42nos., Suites-7nos., Dining area(54 seat) with Kitchen as per the drawing.

Accordingly CPWD has been requested to give estimates for accord of Administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

The committee has been further informed that based on the request CPWD has forwarded a preliminary estimate for ₹39,89,52,000/-including 3% contingencies (Annexure-3). The time limit prescribed by CPWD in the preliminary estimate is 6 months for planning and 24months for execution. The estimate has been framed based on the approved plinth area rate of Govt of India.

The Building and Works Committee deliberated the above provisions and the estimate and resolve to recommend to FC and B.O.G for accord of Administrative approval and Expenditure Sanction for ₹39,89,52,000/-(Rupees Thirty nine crores eighty nine lakhs Fifty two thousand only) for taking up this work.

## ADDITIONAL ITEM NO.1

# Administrative approval and expenditure sanction for providing central Air conditioning plant for administrative building and senate hall

### Resolution No.37/2012

The committee was informed that during the concept stage it has been approved in the master plan to provide central Air condition plant to cater administrative building, senate hall, 200 seater class rooms, and laboratory building south and north, auditorium. This single Air conditioning plant will house in the laboratory block and the chiller unit will serve the AHU in various buildings.

Due to the planning decisions the laboratory block could not be taken up as anticipated to house the plant room. At the same time the administrative and senate hall building scheduled to be commissioned by May 2013. The design of the building is such that without air conditioning it is not feasible to be occupied. Accordingly a meeting was held to resolve the issue with consultant CPGI, Lead consultancy and CPWD.

As an immediate solution it has been decided that a 300 TR unit could be placed in the open area adjacents to administrative building which can be commissioned immediately by drawing power from the existing substation-1. On completion of the laboratory and while installing the main A/c plant this 300 TR unit can be shifted and amalgamated to the main plant.

Accordingly CPWD has forwarded a preliminary estimate for 300 TR for chiller for supplying, installing, testing and commissioning. The estimate is based upon the CPWD scheduled of rates NSR 2008 duly enhanced by the latest cost index applicable to this project with due addition of statutory Taxes including 3% contingencies. The total amount of the estimate works out to Rs.3,49,33,073 rounded off to Rs.3,49,33,000. (Annexure-A1)

The Building and Works Committee deliberated the above provisions and the estimate and resolved to accord administrative approval and expenditure sanction for Rs.3,49,33,000 (Rupees Three crores Forty Nine lakhs thirty three thousand only) for taking up this work.
