It is further informed that for the reason well known to MHRD the preparation of RDPR for IIITDM Kancheepuram & Jabalpur has been entrusted to M/s Education Consultancy India Ltd., Noida. The RDPR Nov 2014 has been circulated during meeting and salient features have been presented. 	BWC has taken note of the above referred sanction and resolved to ratify the action taken by Director, IIITD&M			
Item no.7	Validity Extension of agreement of M/s CPGI Pvt Ltd regarding Master Plan and Comprehensive Architectural Design - reg			
Resolution 7/2015	The Committee has been informed that with the due recommendation of BWC and FC, the BoG has approved to enter into an agreement by IIITDM with M/s CPGI Pvt Ltd for the preparation of Master Plan and Comprehensive Architectural and engineering design for a built up area of 55,000 Sq.m with time limit of 36 months.			
	It has been further informed that with due recommendation of BWC and FC, the BOG have approved the deviation and extra item in the same agreement with the same terms & conditions of agreement for an enhanced area of 1,20,000 Sq.m with an extra item of GRIHA certification consultancy with the extended time limit of 60 months with effect from 20.05.2009. Accordingly the said agreement is in operation with the extended time limit beyond 60 months which came to a close on 20.05.2015 vide resolution nos. 2/2015, 5/2015, 3/2010.			
	The committee has been further informed that as per agreement even after issue of necessary design and drawing the architectural consultant has to render services during the construction stage of the buildings. So it was informed that due to less allocation of the funds all the construction activities could not be completed within the time limit as anticipated and also due to delay in submission plans, statutory clearance etc. The committee was informed that due to non-receipt of request from CPGI for extension of time, the IIITDM has extended the validity of agreement up to 20.05.2016 vide this office letter no. IIITDM/3/2011/350 dated 19.05.2015.			
	The committee was informed that in response to the validity extension order M/s CPGI has not responded positively and in spite of personal discussions held between IIITDM and CPGI, consultant has requested through an email dated 29.06.2015 that the Performance Bank Guarantee may be returned to			

them and a percentage of Performance Guarantee calculated for the remaining work to be done only be retained by IIITDM. It is further informed to the committee the various provisions in the agreement regarding quantum of Performance Guarantee and also mode of release of Performance Guarantee and the time required for completion of all the works by M/s CPGI as per agreement provisions.

Based on the above facts the request has been made for the direction and advice for further course of action by IIITDM.

After deliberating on and carefully considering the various provisions in the Agreement between IIITDM and the Architects (CPGI), the BWC resolved to recommend to the BoG that the main Agreement may be fore-closed and a Supplementary Agreement be entered into with the Architects with a time limit of 3 years for GRIHA portion only. A provisional final bill may be prepared in proportion to the work already done by the agency till date. Part of the performance guarantee (PG) may be released retaining only the remaining part of the PG in proportion to the PG required corresponding to the FEES of the work related to GRIHA rating which will be held against the supplementary Agreement.
