teresting programs where they could write the code on the software and see the output on the arduino. On the whole, the workshop was quite informative and resourceful.


PLACEMENTS 2015

HCI WORKSHOP

Workshop on Human Computer Interaction was organized in the Institute by Dr. Umarani. It dealt with the human-centered approach to the design of computer interactions. The students were introduced to ethnographic research methods and latest trends in HCI for emerging technologies such



as mobile devices and the Internet of Things. Prof. Venkatesh Rajamanickam, IDC Department, IIT Bombay, delivered the lectures. The sessions covered topics such as Ethnographic research methods, contextual inquiry, Micro interactions, User Modeling, Task modeling, Visual Design, Prototyping and Usability and HCI for Internet of Things.
