Minutes of the 27th Meeting of the Board of Governors held at 10.30 A.M. on Friday, 17th October 2014, at IIITD&M Kancheepuram, Chennai – 600 127.

Leave of absence was granted to Smt Rina Sonowal Kouli, Prof Bhaskar Ramamurthi, and Shri Krishna G V Giri. Shri. A Manickavasagam, Secretary, Building and Works Committee, attended the meeting as an Invitee.

Dr. K.P. Issac who was on the Board as a nominee of AICTE has been relieved from the services of AICTE as per the communication received. The Board placed on record its appreciation of the services rendered by Dr. K. P. Isaac.

The Chairman welcomed the members and Prof. R Gnanamoorthy, Director, briefed the members about the functioning of the Institute.

General Discussion

The Director informed the Board members about the Inauguration of New Academic Block (G+4), New Hostel Block, "ASHWATHA" (G+14), and Phase I of Student Dining Block (G+3), AKSHAYA, on 26th July 2014. The Board appreciated the Institute on the well-planned state-of-the-art infrastructure development in a short span of about 3 years from the taking over of the land from the State Government, and for the efficient utilization of land coupled with greenery. The Director briefed about various other activities carried out by the Institute during the reporting period like "Swacha Bharat Mission", Teachers day, Engineers Day, etc. The Board was also informed about the various competitions organized by the Institute to nearby village children on the importance of Cleanliness in addition to the campus cleaning drive by the Faculty, Staff and Students of the Institute.

The Board was briefed about the Student Admission details (July 2014). The members wanted to know about the response to the Dual Degree programme. The Director informed that the Dual degree programme was also well received by the students. The fact that the starting ranks of B.Tech and the Dual Degree do not differ by much is a proof of the interest it has generated among the students. Further all the seats were filled.

The Members also advised the Institute to conduct special classes, coaching camps, etc for the welfare of reserved community students on the soft skills. The Director briefed the members about the initiative taken by the Institute in this regard.

The Board members noted the initiative of the Institute in revising the criteria and the eligibility norms for the visiting faculty and advised the Institute to circulate the requirement to neighboring industries. Qualified Industry personnel who are willing to teach can be roped in as a visiting faculty for the benefit of the students. Further the

Board also desired that the eligibility norms be modified to "Industry/ Institution" in place of industry alone so that qualified personnel from any R & D Institution can also be roped in for teaching.

While reviewing the Annual Accounts, The Board requested that the per-student expenditure incurred by other New Institutes, IIT/IIIT/IISER, etc., be reported in the next Meeting.
