General Discussion

The Chairman welcomed the members to the Meeting.

The Chairman and member of the Board felicitated former Director Prof R Gnanamoorthy who was invited by the Board. The members were unanimous in appreciating his services to the Institute. The board placed on record the untiring and persistent effort of Prof R Gnanamoorthy in bringing up this nascent Institute to the present level and wished him a successful career. The chairman and the members of the Board extended a warm welcome to Prof Banshidhar Majhi, the new Director of the Institute and wished him a success in his new assignment.

The Director presented the existing infrastructure/facilities available at the Institute and also outlined his short term and long term priorities. The board appreciated the initiative proposed by the Director.

The Board further discussed the followings.

- (a) The Board approved, in principle, the recruitment of regular faculty for the post of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor. The Board advised the Institute to forward the recruitment notification to all NITs, IITs etc. to attract the potential candidates.
- (b) The Board noted the proposal of improving the perception of the Institute and in this regard advised the Institute to conduct various seminar/conferences etc. and also host the same for other institutes.
- (c) The Board further pressed upon the Institute to invite the members of FICCI & CII etc. for better visibility. The Board also advised for the digital campaign for improving the public perception. The Director informed about the Industry Institute conclave planned by the Institute for collaboration as well as for visibility.
- (d) The Director further informed about utilising "Alumni Association" as a torch bearer of the Institute.
- (e) The Board looked into the proposal of Augmentation of water supply to the Institute. The Board desired for a detailed plan about the water requirement, sourcing of water, disposing of water and rain water harvesting etc. in the next meeting for its consideration.
- (f) The Board further enquired about the details regarding the utilization of nearby quarry and the desired that a detailed plan of action for efficient utilization of water and encompassment of the quarry area in consultation with District Administration.

	MHRD vide its order dated 23.06.2017 appointed Prof. Banshidhar Majhi, Professor, Dept.of CSE, National Institute of Technology, Rourkela, Odisha as new Director of IIITDM Kancheepuram on a fixed pay of Rs.75000 plus Special allowance of Rs.5000 per month with usual allowances (Annexure A). This appointment shall be on contract basis for a period of 5 years with effect from the date of assuming the charge or till he attains the age of 65 years whichever is earlier
	Prof. Banshidhar Majhi has taken over the charges of Director on 26.07.2017 and also signed a contract in terms of provision 16(1) of Statutes of the institute. He has also taken over the charge of Mentor Director, IIITDM Kurnool. The Board was informed that the Director is holding the charge of Registrar, IIITDM Kancheepuram and requested for continuation of the

	Pursuant to appointment of Prof. Banshidhar Majhi as new Director, Prof. R. Gnanamoorthy handed over the charge of Director on 26.07.2017 and relieved from the institute to enable him to join IIT Madras, his parent organization.
	The Board noted the completion of tenure of Prof. R Gnanamoorthy and resolved to place in record its appreciation for the service rendered by him in creating best infrastructure and specialized curriculum for the institute.
