GENERAL DISCUSSION:

- 1. The Director made the presentation on the academic and other activities at the Institute and explained about the online teaching processes happening at the Institute. However, BOG wanted to know how the practical/lab sessions are being handled. The Director explained about the use virtual labs sessions by the faculty and technical assistants to make it effective. The Board advised the Institute to give equal focus on the practical learning in additional to theoretical concepts which is an important component in engineering education.
- 2. The Director explained about the successful online convocation of the Institute due to pandemic and the informed that the degree certificates have also been dispatched to students. The Board noted the same and wanted to know regarding the performance of the students in their current employment. BOG also advised the Institute to formulate a plan for collection of continuous evaluation/feedback from their employers which will help the Institute to incorporate those

suggestions/feedback in the framing the future curriculum and grooming of the Institute.

3. The Director also presented the formation of Sub-Groups headed by a BOG member to focus on specific areas and the board advised the Institute to submit the detailed plan in the next meeting for discussion.

Creation of Department of Humanities and Basic Sciences

It is submitted that the Institute is having three major engineering departments namely Mechanical Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering and Computer Science and Engineering in addition to the two basic science departments of Mathematics and Physics. With approval of the board, The institute has created School of Interdisciplinary Design and Innovation (SIDI) to strengthen the design spine curriculum. The willingness of the faculty has been obtained to be part of the SIDI either through complete migration or participation remaining in their parent department. Based on the options exercised by the faculty, the design department is functional now.

However, the New Educational Policy, 2020 (NEP-2020) thrust of interdisciplinary education and research with a special thrust to Literature, Culture, Sports, Bio-Sciences, Economics and many more. Keeping this in mind, the institute plan to recruit faculty from these streams, however the numbers will be limited. Hence, creating individual departments in each subject will not be possible. **Thus, it is proposed to create a School of Humanities and Basic Sciences (SHBS).** This faculty of Physics, Mathematics, Bio-Medical, Bio-Technology, Bio-Informatics, English, Economics, Contemporary Arts, Music etc. However, the faculty will be permitted to supervise research scholars in their respective core area and the degree will be awarded accordingly.

The Board discussed the matter at length and varied suggestions/options proposed by the members were deliberated and desired to have further discussion on the agenda item.

The Board decided to defer the agenda for the next meeting.

Recruitment of Faculty positions in the Institute

The Institute had notified the recruitment of faculty position in the streams of Computer Science and Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Design, Physics, Mathematics and English vide notification IIITDMK/R/1/2020 and the same was published in the newspapers for wide publicity. The last date of receipt of application was 15th April, 2020. Further, the institute has also notified the faculty recruitment in IIITDM website as Rolling Advertisement. The application received against the regular advertisement and against the Rolling Advertisement upto 31st July, 2020 was considered by the scrutiny committee in order to shortlist the candidates for seminar presentation.

The shortlisted candidates were invited for seminar presentation through online mode before the committee consisting of senior faculty of the Institute and external experts. The seminar presentations were held for each department separately and the candidates selected in the seminar presentation were invited to appear before the selection committee.

The Selection Committee were constituted department wise as per the Clause 9 (5)&(6) of the statute consisting of expert members including SC/ST Members from the expert members approved by the Chairman, BoG and Chairman, Senate **Annexure "B" & "C".** The entire selection process was conducted during 04-28

December,2020 through online mode.

The detailed proceedings of the selection committee for the department of Computer Science Engineering, Electronics and communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Design, Physics, Mathematics and English are enclosed as **Annexure "D"**.



Conversion of the post of Security Officers to the post in Administrative Cadre

It is submitted that one posts each of Chief Security Officer, Deputy Security Officer and Assistant Security Officer were sanctioned by the Ministry of Education and the same post were not filled up as the Security Services were outsourced and manned by contract manpower. Further, it is submitted that as per the Recruitment and Promotion Norms 2016 for Non-faculty staff of IIIT's the post of Assistant Security Officer (PB-2; 9300-34800 + GP 4200) is the entry level direct recruitment post and the promotion hierarchy is as under



Hence as per the RPN 2016 the post of assistant security officer is a direct recruitment and ultimately merges with the Assistant Registrar.

It is submitted that the post of Assistant Security Officer which is a Direct Recruitment post is not filled and eventually the post of Deputy Security Officer and Chief Security Officer is also lying vacant/merge with Assistant registrar post.

The institute has a small campus with limited number of staff and the security services are manned through outsourcing and the supervision of the outsourced security staff is effectively carried out through Assistant

Registrar/Registrar/Faculty I/C (Security).

In order to effectively utilize the vacant post, it is proposed to convert the said post into equivalent administrative cadre post to strengthen the administrative cadre for effective support to the faculty.

As per Clause 6(III)&(VIII) of part 1 of RPN Norms of 2016 the Director/Board has the power to restructure any service and amend the provision of RPN. Therefore, the following restructure/amendment of post is proposed.

Leave on Academic Grounds:

- 1. Leave can be granted for the purpose of academic growth of the regular faculty member for the beneficial purpose to the Institute in pursuit of excellence.
- 2. The leave of absence overlapping two or more semesters shall be termed as long leave.
- 3. The faculty after availing the leave is supposed to serve the Institute for a period which shall be specified by the Board.

Eligibility

- 4. The eligibility for long leave state that the faculty should have served the Institute for five years after joining and the eligibility can be relaxed up to two years for Assistant professor for the first time in their tenure.
- 5. A faculty member shall be eligible for leaves only when it is ensured that the teaching and other academic activities of the institute shall not be jeopardized and Department has enough faculty members to handle the academic requirements.

In this regard, it is submitted that

- 1. Dr. Asutosh Kar has joined the Institute on 11.05.2018 and does not have qualifying service of five years, however as per the norms the eligibility for grant of Long leave, the conditions can be relaxed up to two years for Assistant Professors for the first time in their tenure. This is his first application for grant of long leave and on extending the relaxation benefit of two years, he would have served the Institute for three years as on date of proposed grant of EOL from 17.05.2021.
- 2. Further, the faculty member has to serve the Institute for a period specified by the Board after availing the leave and a bond to this effect has to be furnished. It is submitted that the Dr. Asutosh kar may be asked to serve the Institute for a period of three years after availing the leave and he can be asked to execute the bond to the effect before proceeding on leave.
- 3. The Head of the Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering has recommended his case for consideration and certified that the department has enough faculty members to handle the academic requirement and the academic activity of the Institute shall not be jeopardized.
- 4. Dr. Asutosh Kar can be granted EOL on academic grounds as requested by him from 17th May 2021 to 31st July 2021 covering a period of four academic semesters and he shall be required to use the name of IIITDM Kancheepuram in all affiliations during his research work at Aalborg University.

5. During the period of EOL he shall not be paid any salary and allowances by the Institute.

The Board discussed the same and approved the proposal for grant of EOL with furnishing of Bond to serve the Institute for three years after availing the leave. Further, any request of extension of leave may not be entertained and violation any clause may lead to dismissal of his job.
