A.1 Approval of the Minutes of 4th Academic Advisory Committee Meeting

A.2 Approval of the curriculum of the B Tech (Design and Manufacturing)

Resolution No.1/2008

The Academic Advisory Committee approved the curriculum of the B Tech (Design and Manufacturing) given in Annexure A.

A.3 To report the constitution of Course Advisory Committees (CAC) formed to look into the development of two new undergraduate programs: electronics stream and computer engineering.

The AAC noted the constitution of the CACs. The minutes of the Course Advisory Committee meetings held to look into the possible development of new undergraduate programs were discussed.

Resolution No.2/2008 The AAC accepted, in principle, creation of two undergraduate level programs which can be named as Electronics (Design and Manufacturing) and Computer Engineering. The AAC also expressed the CACs should develop the curriculum in discussion with the experts from industry.

A.4 Introduction of M S / Ph D Programme

The AAC **noted** the introduction of new M S and Ph D programs in the academic session July 2008-09. Members also felt initially the research programs could be offered under full time regular category only. The Chairman briefed about the proposal of introducing a postgraduate research programme (M S by Research) and a doctoral research programme (Ph D).
